Minority Institution Research Support (MIRS) Program History

2002 - the Minority Institution Research Support (MIRS) program was started by the NAI.

The objectives of the program are:

- to increase the number of faculty from Minority Serving Institutions (MSIs) who are actively and competitively engaged in astrobiology research and related pursuits
- to increase the number of students from underrepresented groups who successfully pursue careers in astrobiology.

MIRS Program History 2 of 2

2002 – 2005 - developed and managed by an NAI staff member

2005 – proposal from Tennessee State University, an HBCU, managed the program through 2010

2010 – MIRS Cooperative Agreement Notice

2011 – 2013 the United Negro College Fund Special Program Corporation was selected under a 4-year agreement. In 2013. UNCF-SP had financial difficulties and was forced to close in late 2013.

NAI Central has managed the program since January 2014.

MIRS Program

The program provides for:

- a stipend for up to 10 weeks
- travel and lodging support
- an optional award following the sabbatical, intended to support continuing the research and involving students, and/or develop astrobiology laboratories or curriculum at the home institution.

MIRS Status

As of summer 2017, the MIRS Program has supported 30 faculty members from Minority Serving Institutions (MSIs) to participate in astrobiology research

Of the 30 MIRS Fellows, 20 were faculty at Historically Black Colleges and Universities, 8 at Hispanic Serving Institutions, and two at Native Serving Institutions. The Fellows have remained engaged, some for over 10 years, and would all likely welcome an opportunity to re-propose.
