


Mission: Find Life!

An Astrobiology Exhibit at the Pacific Science Center



Mission: Find Life! guides visitors through a journey of how astrobiologists are searching for life elsewhere in the Universe.

The exhibit explores how astrobiologists study extreme environments to understand the potential habitability of extraterrestrial environments, as well as examines how life might arise on planets orbiting stars that are very different than our Sun.



In a one hands-on activity, three different sized planets spin around a star, and a “Kepler” sensor measures the apparent brightness of the star.

This new exhibit is part of the “Portal to Current Research” area of the Pacific Science Center, and will be on display from March 18-September 15, 2017.
